SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, MARCH 18, 2025, 6:00 P.M.**

Attendance: Selectmen: Jim Dolloff, Robert Flint, Dale Miner as well as members of the Public.

1. **Review/ Approve minutes.** Robert Flint moved to accept and approve March 4th, 2025, minutes as written. Dale Miner seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the minutes.
2. **Review/ Approve warrant.** Dale Miner moved to accept and approve the March 18th, 2025, warrant. Robert Flint seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the warrant.
 - Robert Flint proposed responding to the Calderwood Engineering Phase III inspection proposal for the River Road Pigeon Brook Culvert Project proposing approximately \$4,800.00 by focusing on inspections at specific periods throughout the project. Robert Flint moved to forward the proposal for \$4,800.00. Jim Dolloff seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 in favor. Robert is to prepare a document for the Selectmen to sign.
 - Jim Dolloff mentioned receipt of the State of Maine Department of Education's State Calculation for Funding Public Education briefing. Robert Flint noted, although the State looks at the number of Baldwin students sent to the RSU, the amount is not based on the number of Baldwin students. State municipal evaluation determines the Town's percentage of the total.
